



SM Goh to meet Chinese leaders during official visit

SINGAPORE : Singapore's Senior Minister Goh Chok Tong will begin an official visit to China on Monday at the invitation of the Chinese government.

During his seven-day trip, Mr Goh will meet Chinese Prime Minister Wen Jiabao and the chairman of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference, Jia Qinglin, in Beijing.

State Councillor Tang Jiaxuan will also host an official dinner for the Senior Minister.

Mr Goh will then visit Suzhou and Shanghai, where he will meet provincial leaders for updates on developments there.

He will also visit the Suzhou Industrial Park.

Mr Goh will be accompanied by his wife as well as Minister of State for Finance and Transport Lim Hwee Hua, Member of Parliament Seng Han Thong and senior government officials.

From China, Mr Goh will head to Washington DC for the first meeting of the World Bank Commission on Growth and Development, accompanied by senior officials.

He returns to Singapore on April 22. - CNA /ct
